4. User assumes all responsibility of copyright and invasion of privacy that may arise in copying and in the use made of photographic copies.

6. Preservation Virginia reserves the right to restrict the use of rare or valuable materials; to make special price quotations for materials involving unusual difficulty in copying, and to charge a higher fee than specified in those incidents.

*Images for website use are required to be no larger than 800 pixels on any side in their published form. Reproduction fee includes rights for image use and thumbnail use. Electronic rights may be bundled as a courtesy for textbooks and other educational products. Otherwise, the above rates apply.

Tour Publicity

Non-profit organizations sponsoring trips to Preservation Virginia sites for which they are paying standard admission fees are entitled to the use of one image from the image bank for use in promoting their tour free of charge. Organizations receiving fee waivers to visit Preservation Virginia sites are allowed a single image at the standard non-profit editorial rate.

For-profit organizations may have a single image at the standard editorial rate as a courtesy (\$150 for color digital images). Additional images will be charged at the advertising rate.

Guidebooks

Publishers of guidebooks and other literature that is specifically intended to help visitors learn about and visit our historic sites (must include directions, contact information, website, phone number, and other relevant information to qualify) are entitled to the use of two images free of charge or for the waiver of all fees associated with printing their own photographs of Preservation Virginia sites in exchange for appropriate credit in the caption of the image *and* text review by a Preservation Virginia staff member.
